## Math

### Fractions

The top number in a fraction is called the numerator. The bottom number in a fraction is called the denominator.

### Examples:

Numbering	Fraction	Equal to	Numbering	Fraction	Equal to
1/2	numerator denominator	Equal, Larger or Smaller	3/5	numerator denominator	Equal, Larger or Smaller
$\frac{2}{4}$	numerator denominator	Equal, Larger or Smaller	1/7	numerator denominator	Equal, Larger or Smaller
1/4	1 is the numerator 4 is the denominator	Equal, Larger or Smaller	1/8	$\frac{1 \text{ is the numerator}}{8 \text{ is the denominator}}$	Equal, Larger or Smaller
2/7	2 is the numerator 7 is the denominator	Equal, Larger or Smaller
